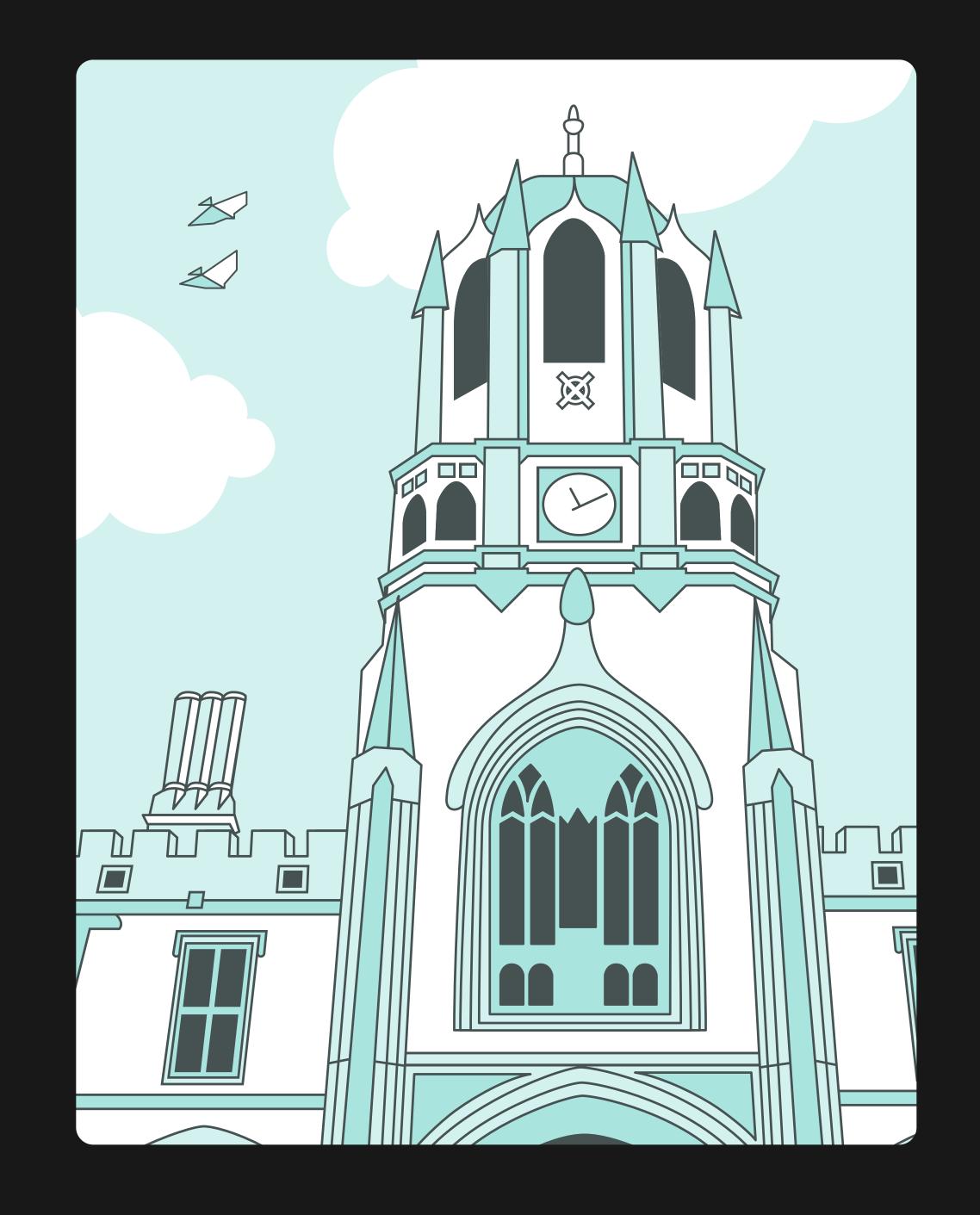
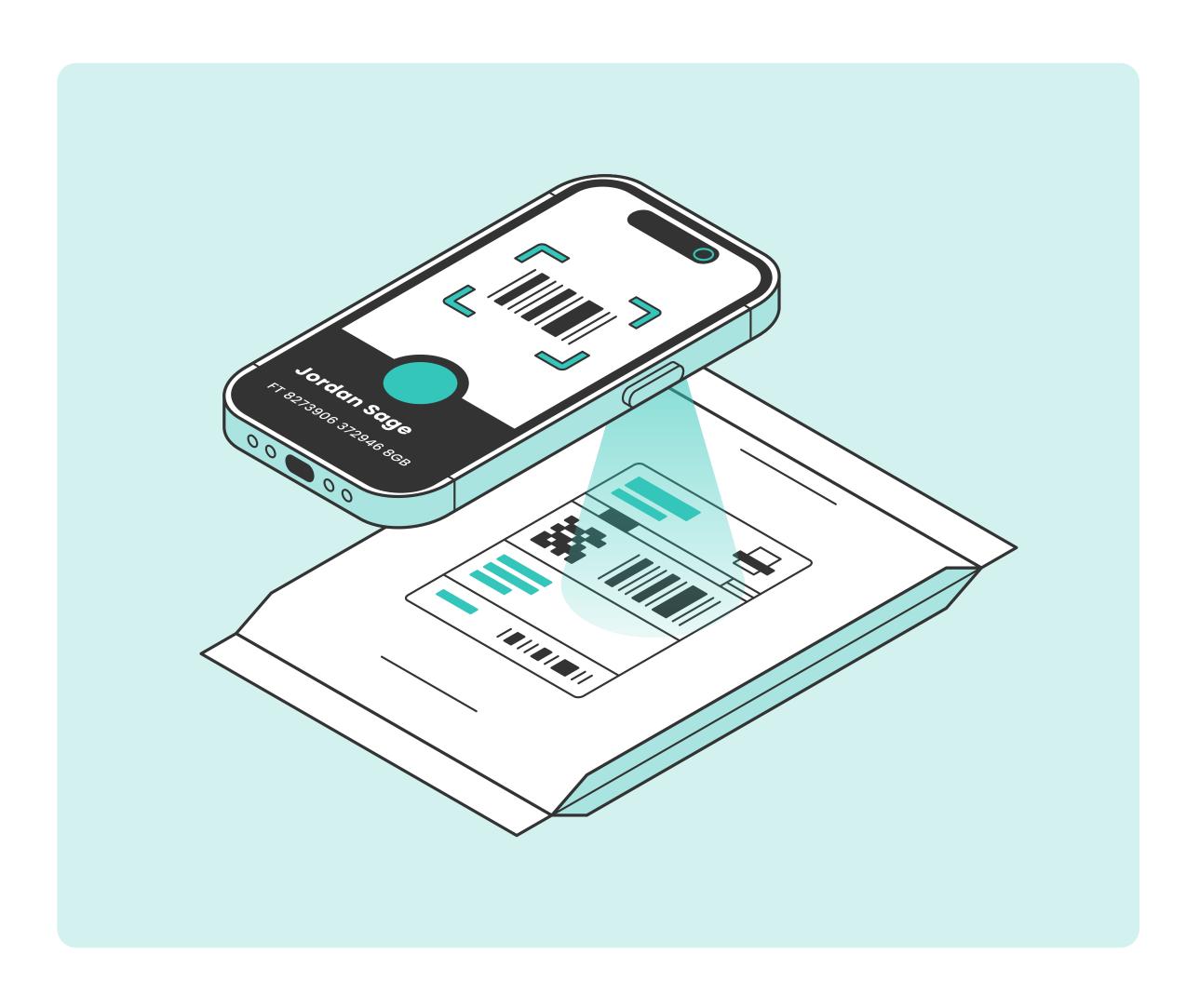

Parcel Workflow



- 1. Couriers deliver parcels to the building
- 2. Staff sort and log parcels using the Parcel Tracker app
- 3. Parcel Tracker notifies recipients via email with a QR code
- 4. Recipients present their QR code at the mailroom for collection

Long parcel handling times disrupted staff interactions and reduced customer satisfaction.

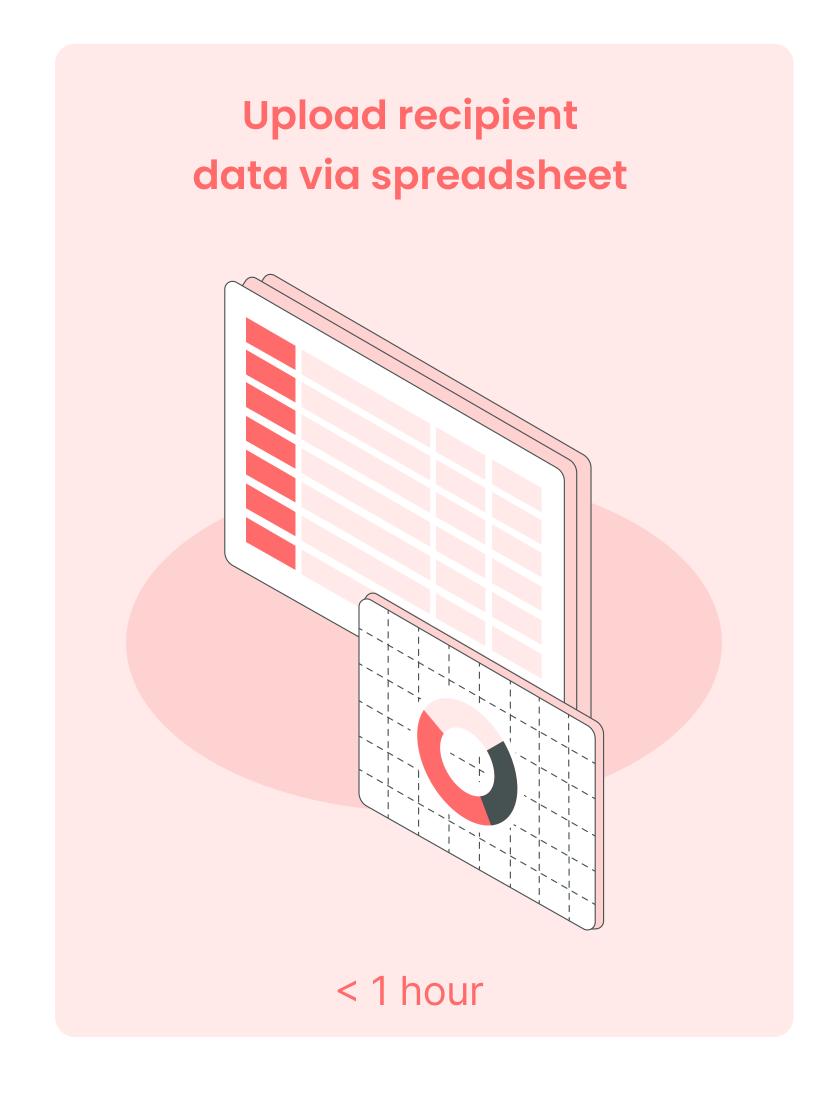


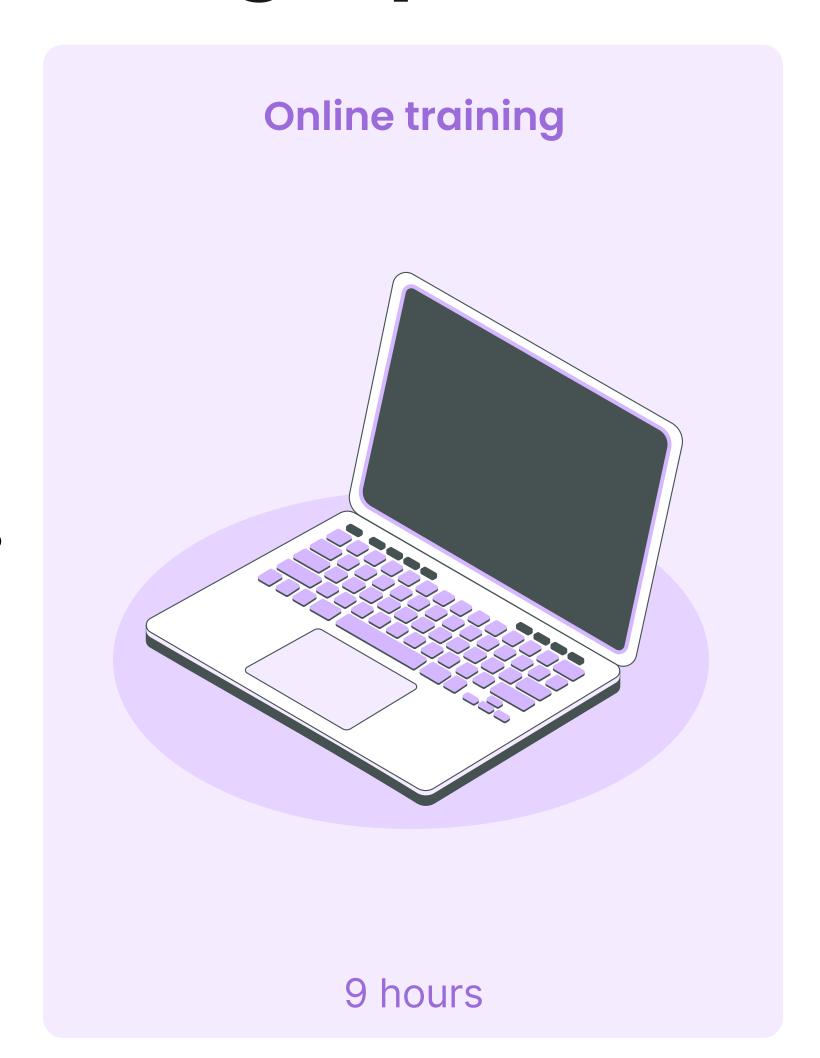
Time spent on managing parcels pulled focus away from other critical tasks.

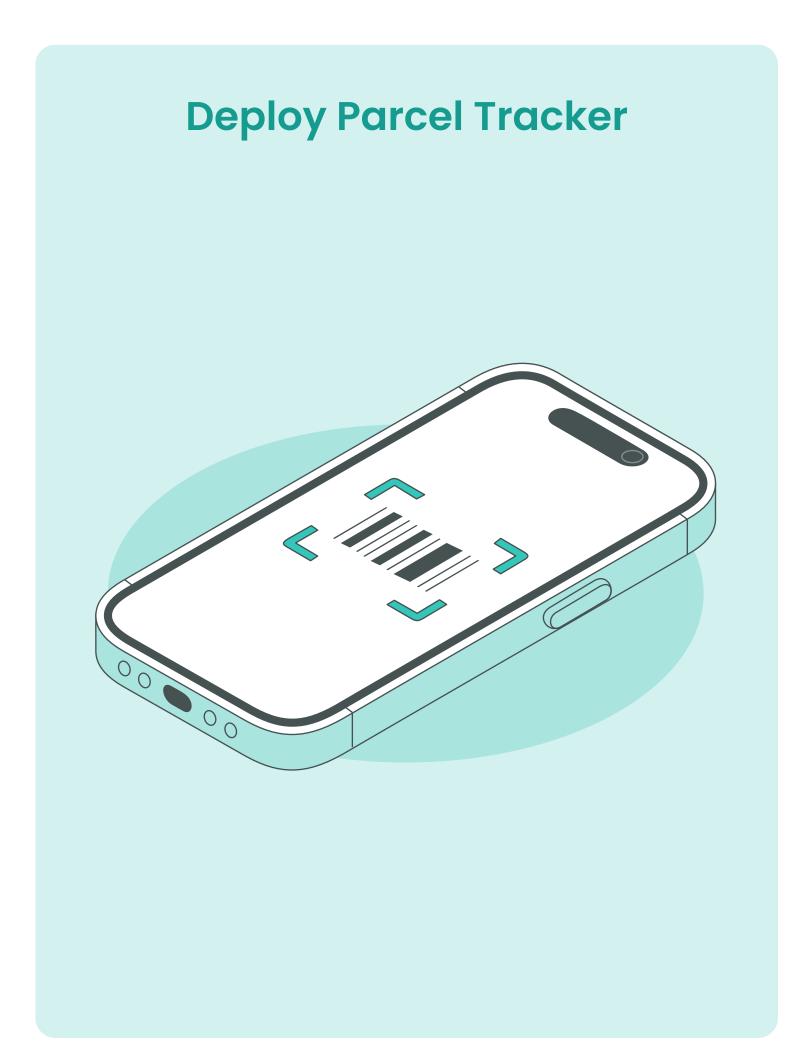


Poor communication systems caused delayed deliveries and overcrowded mailrooms.

The Process of Setting Up Parcel Tracker



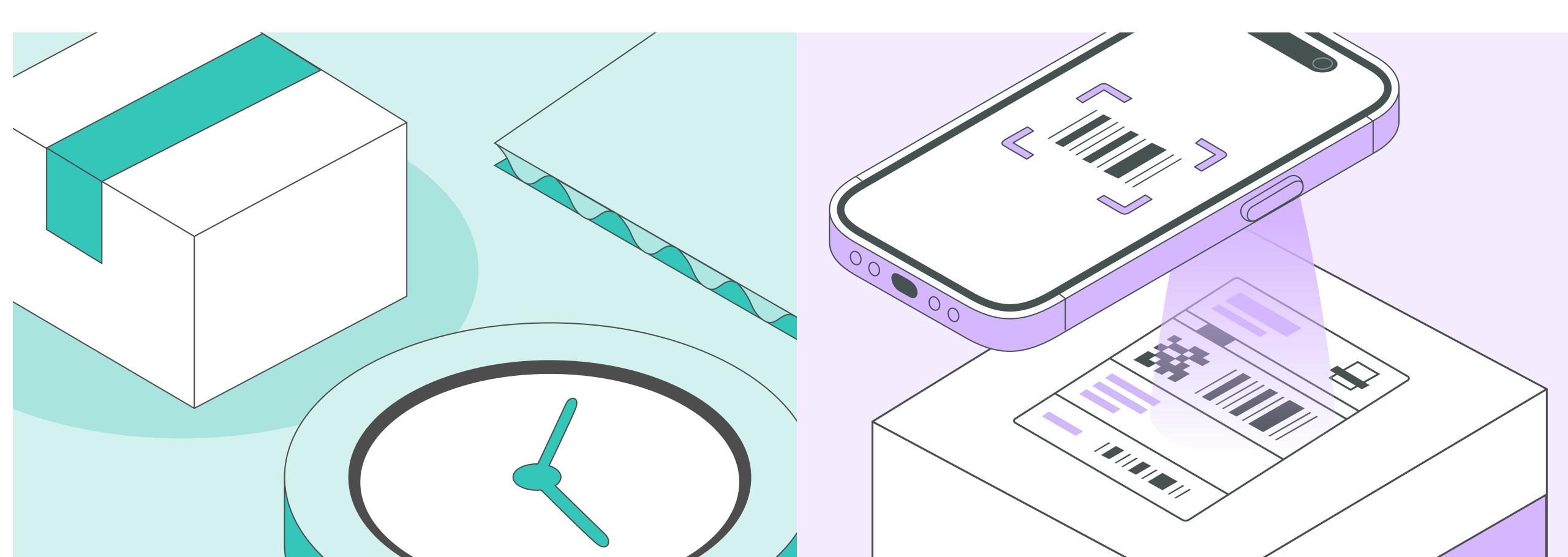




Time Spent Logging Parcels

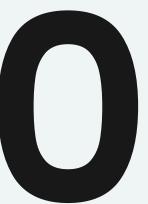

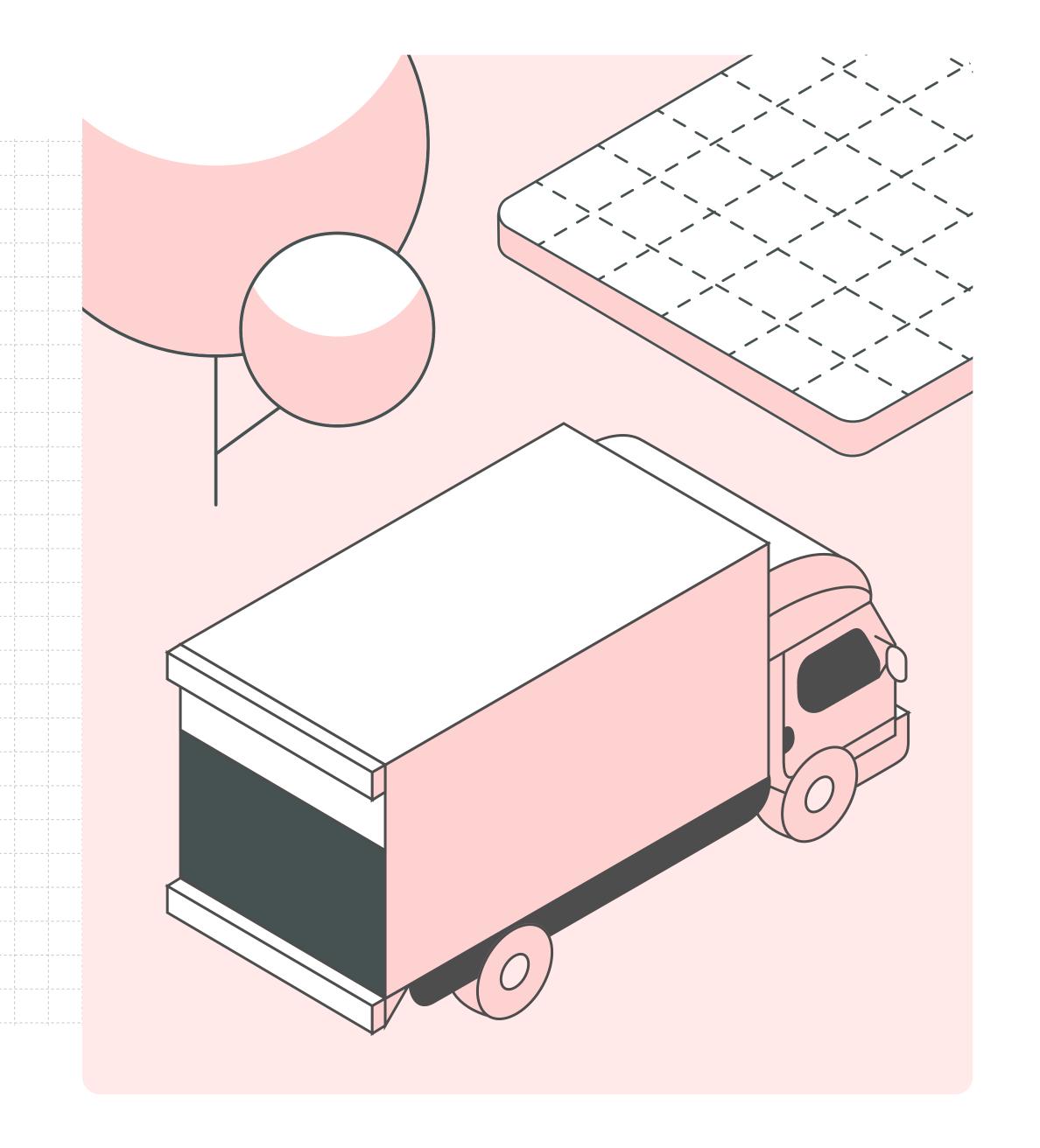

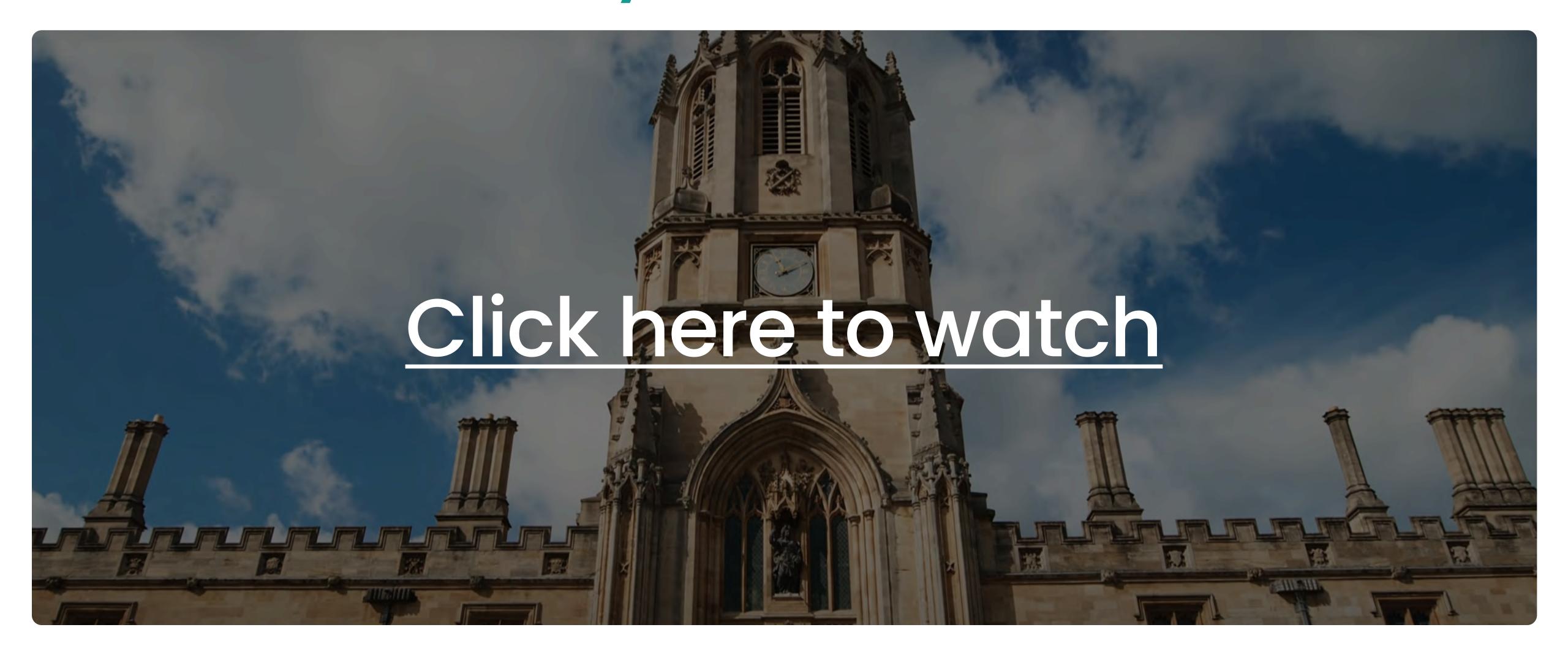
