Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Compliance (US-specific)

General Safety Training

- hazard recognition
- · personal protective equipment
- · safe lifting practices

Hazard Communication Standard (HazCom)

 training about handling chemicals (MSDS/SDS usage)

Forklift Operation Certification

if operating powered industrial trucks

Emergency Action Plan Training

fire, evacuation, severe weather

Bloodborne Pathogens Training

if employees might be exposed

Department of Transportation (DOT) Compliance (US-specific)

Driver Qualification File Requirements

background checks, medical certifications

Hours of Service (HOS) Rules Training

limits on driving hours

Drug & Alcohol Testing Program

· mandatory for CDL (Commercial Driver's License) holders

Roadside Inspection Awareness

preparing for DOT inspections

Environmental Compliance

Hazardous Materials (HAZMAT) Training

- if transporting hazardous goods
- Required by DOT and Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA)
- Includes general awareness, safety training, security awareness, and function-specific training.

Spill Prevention and Response Training

especially for fuel and chemical spills

Security Compliance

Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Programs

 for air cargo handlers (e.g., Certified Cargo Screening Facilities)

Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism (C-TPAT) Awareness Training

 for companies involved in international shipping

Cybersecurity Awareness Training

· especially for shipment tracking and customer data protection

Company-and Role-Specific Compliance

Equipment Handling

e.g., cranes, conveyors, loading docks

Defensive Driving Courses

often required annually

Customer Data Privacy Training

 GDPR compliance if operating in or with Europe

First Aid and CPR

often required for warehouse supervisors

TRAINING FREQUENCY

Type of Training	Frequency
Safety (General)	Annually
Forklift Certification	Every 3 years
HAZMAT Training	Every 3 years
Drug and Alcohol Awareness	Annually
Defensive Driving	Every 1-2 years
Cybersecurity Training	Annually



IMPORTANT NOTES:

Recordkeeping is mandatory:

Companies must document employee completion of each required training and maintain logs for several years.

Non-compliance can result in major fines, legal liability, and even loss of licenses.
