### WHAT MADE THIS EVENT UNIQUE?

To replicate the fun and competitive atmosphere of the road ride, the team created 12 weeks of fun challenges. The challenges ranged from cycling to fundraising to sharing a favorite carb-loading dinner. They alternated weekly between physical and fundraising goals.

Each physical challenge had two options so everyone could participate – a challenge for avid cyclists and one for the "athletic supporters."

They also hosted Matching Gift days, offered challenge prizes, and recognized sponsors supported the Virtual Ride.
