

X12 Cheat Sheet

A quick reference of X12 fundamentals







An X12 document is structured by three segment pairs — from top-to-bottom — as pictured above. The bulk of the data, however, generally lies between the ST and SE segments.

1. SEGMENTS & ELEMENTS

An X12 document is made up of two parts:

SEGMENT:

Part of the file that holds specific information, usually separated by a new line. It starts with a three-character segment name (e.g. ITD, SAC, etc.) and ends with a segment terminator character (~ in the example above).

ELEMENT:

The subsection of a segment that contains specific information. Each element is separated by the element separator character (* in the example above). Multiple elements typically reside in a segment. Each can be referenced by its segment name and number in the sequence of elements (e.g. IT101, IT103).

Each segment in an X12 file conveys specific information. For example, the IT1 segment conveys line item information.

IT1*1*4*EA*8.60**UP*99999330023

IT101 - Line Number - 1

IT102 - Quantity - 4

IT103 - Unit of Measure - EA

IT104 - Unit Price - 8.60

IT106 - Qualifier ID - UP - UPC Code

IT107 - UPC Code - 999999330023

A sequence of element separators (e.g. *****) in a segment typically means that either a trading partner has omitted or doesn't provide data for those missing elements.

2. THE 3 HIERARCHIES IN X12

- 1. The Interchange (ISA) segment usually one per file contains information about a trading partner, timestamps, document control numbers, and X12 version. Corresponding closing segment = IEA.
- 2. The Group (GS) segment contains the same type of information as the ISA segment, with a possible exception of a partner ID tag to distinguish different entities (like departments) of the same organization. Corresponding closing segment = GE.
- 3. The Transaction (ST) segment signifies the start of the transactions in an X12 document with transaction type code (e.g. 810, 850, 856) and control number. Each transaction type uses many of its own unique segments.

 Corresponding closing segment = SE.

3. QUALIFIERS

When additional detail about certain data needs to be communicated, elements in a segment can be used to qualify the information in the subsequent field(s). In the example below, a qualifier for SAC (additional charges) in the SAC02 elements (D240 and H750) can reveal whether the charges in another element are related to taxes or freight costs.

SAC*C*<u>D240</u>***100~ SAC*C*<u>H750</u>***50~

4. X12 TRANSMISSION METHODS

Though an X12 document can be exchanged a variety of ways (often depending on your partner), the most popular methods are via AS2 or VAN. Here's the low-down on both:

- AS2 is a direct connection to a partner.
 The configuration is relatively simple. You'll need to exchange AS2 specifications and certificates with your partner. You'll upload the partner's AS2 ID and certificate during configuration.
- A VAN (value-added network) is an interconnect or a third party that manages the connections between you and a partner. You send an X12 document to your VAN, your VAN sends to your partner's VAN, and then your partner's VAN transmits to your partner.

5. TRADING PARTNER ID

Trading partner IDs in the ISA and GS segments are unique identifiers assigned to an organization and then registered in the VAN network. The IDs tell VANs where they need to transfer X12 documents. In the example X12 document above, the Sender ID in the ISA and GS segements are different because the GS Sender ID Specifies a sub-division within an organization.
